PPCC Pistol Range

Hours of Operation

Sunday - Noon to 6:00 PM

Monday, Wednesday, Friday and Saturday - 8:00 AM to 8:00 PM
Closed Tuesdays and Thursdays

RANGE RULES:

- 1. All members must have in their possession their membership ID and a valid range pass to use this range.
- 2. Eye and ear protection must be worn at all times on the range.
- 3. No smoking on the firing line.
- 4. No alcohol allowed on or around the range.
- 5. All guests must be accompanied and assisted by a PPCC club member. No more than 2 guests. All shooters must have basic knowledge of firearm safety before using the range.
- 6. No minors on the range unless directly supervised by adult club member.
- 7. All guests over 18 years of age must pay a \$5.00 range fee. All shooters are required to sign a "hold harmless" agreement prior to using the range.
- 8. Portable targets are allowed only if approved by range safety officer or range chariman. Steel targets must be under enclosed roof area. No ground, pop-up or exploding targets allowed. Bullets must end up in dirt berm under the roof area.
- 9. Do not place targets over support posts, timbers or target frame work. Silhouette targets permitted, no "faces".
- 10. NO FULL AUTO.
- 11. Pistol caliber and rim fire rifles are allowed on the pistol range. No center fire rifle, muzzleloading rifles or shotguns allowed.
- 12. .45 caliber maximum allowed on club provided steel plates. No magnum calibers allowed on club provided steel plates. Lead and plated bullets on steel targets please.
- 13. All firearms shall be cased when entering or leaving range area.
- 14. Only 1 person allowed in each shooting lane.
- 15. No cross lane shooting.
- 16. Firearms at the shooting line must be pointed down range at all times.
- 17. All actions shall be open with a flag in the chamber except when firing.
- 18. All shooting must be done behind the firing line. No shooting from down the range.
- 19. Use lights provided when making range "cold".
- 20. Pistol range must go cold when rifle range is cold. Pistol shooters should first be notified before the lights are turned on. Rifle range does not go cold for the pistol range.
- 21. When the range is "cold" all firearms are to be unloaded, chamber flags inserted and shooters are required to stay behind safety line and not handle any firearms until firing resumes.
- 22. Please remove targets and throw away garbage before leaving the range.
- 23. The attending range safety officer or any club member can remove a shooter for unsafe conduct.
- 24. Any violation of these rules or unsafe conduct will result in the subject/member to appear before the board of directors for discipline to up and including expulsion from the club.
